Questions for Reflection & Discussion

1. Read Matthew 3:7-12. Why do you think John the Baptist expected Jesus to give people what they deserved? Do you think he was mistaken in his prediction or just in his timeline? (Revelation 14:14 might help.)
2. Read Mark 1:40-42, Mark 9:25-27 and Mark 10:13-16. How would you describe the touch of Jesus in these passages? Who do you know that needs this kind of touch right now?
3. Read John 9:1-7 and John 14:12-14. When and how have you experienced a healing touch from God? How do you think He wants to use you to touch others with His healing power?
4. Read Matthew 14:14-32. How has the Lord met a practical need in your life recently? Who has a practical need that you can meet right now? How will you do it?
5. Read 1 John 3:16. Do you think that, to lay down your life right now, you need to do something with your hands or refrain from doing something with them? Why?
