Questions for Reflection & Discussion

1. Read John 5:30, John 8:29, John 12:50 and Galatians 1:10. In what situations are you most tempted to be a people-pleaser instead of a God-pleaser?
2. Read Matthew 4:3-10, Matthew 19:4-6 and Colossians 3:16. What have you done to fill your mind with Scripture in the past? What can you realistically do in the future to be more biblical in your thinking?
3. Read Matthew 7:12; Mark 3:4 and Galatians 5:14. How might you use Scripture to violate the law of love? How can you love others without violating Scripture?
4. Read Mark 10:43-45, John 13:12-15 and Philippians 2:3-7. Who do you tend to view as having lower status than you? How can you reverse that perspective?
5. Read John 14:6, Acts 4:12 and 1 Timothy 2:5. Does the truth in these verses find its way out of your mouth? If not, why not?
