QUESTIONS FOR REFLECTION & DISCUSSION

1. Take the time to read the following passages (out loud, if possible): Genesis 17:1; Genesis 18:14; Jeremiah 32:17; Jeremiah 32:27 and Luke 1:37. In your own words, what do these verses teach about God?
2. In what area of your life do you feel most defeated or weak? Why? What have you done to try to "be stronger" in this area?
3. According to Ephesians 1:18-20 and Ephesians 3:16-21, where is the power of God active? In what ways have you experienced God's power personally? In what new ways would you like for Him to display His power in you?
4. Which of the three characteristics of power-activating faith (on your note sheet) do you struggle with most? How can you strengthen this aspect of your faith?
5. Do you think faith is all it takes to activate God's power? What other factors might be involved? (Try to back up your answers with Scripture!)
