4. Read Psalms 51:1-11, Isaiah 54:8 and Micah 7:18. For what do you feel unforgiven? How do you think the new covenant, sealed with the blood of Jesus, changes the way God sees you?

5. Read Hebrews 4:16. How do you most need God to express His unfailing love to you right now?
